### ***PROCLAIM THE WORD!***

With this lector schedule we include all the Sundays of Lent, Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday. This is such a powerful and insightful time in our liturgical calendar. It will be very important for each one of us, as we prepare the readings we are assigned, to truly embrace and understand what we are proclaiming. We all need to take the time and energy to read all the backgrounds of our readings and the helpful tips that our Lector Workbooks include for all the readings. Take some time, also, to read through the gospel of the particular mass where you will be lector. Keeping that main theme in mind will help in your preparation and your delivery of your readings.

Each time we approach our ministry, we do so with openness as to where God is and as to where God is calling us at that moment. We need to keep ourselves "open" to really "hearing" the word we are proclaiming, understanding the word we are proclaiming and then share, as totally as we can, the word with the congregation. This is a big challenge! It can only be accomplished with prayer. Pray with your readings as you prepare them. Ask the Holy Spirit to "open" your heart, mind and soul to God's word so that you in turn can then share His word with others.

Especially during Holy Week (Palm Sunday through the Easter Vigil), we use the same readings every year. It is so easy to say, "I know this passage. I've heard it or proclaimed it before." Don't let yourself get caught up in this way of thinking. We can hear these passages differently each time we encounter them. If we are truly growing in our faith, we are not the same as we were the last time we heard or proclaimed these familiar readings. Each encounter with these familiar readings should always be treated as a fresh and new encounter with our Lord. Be open to that "new encounter" and share that "freshness" with the congregation!
